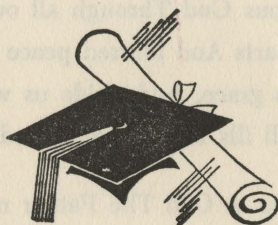

And free us from all ills In this world and the next.

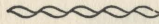
