#### PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES OF SIMMONS NFA CAMP Swansboro, North Carolina

1959-60-61-62-63

This is a summary of CAMP PARTICIPATION from 1959 - 1963, showing the number of students brought to the Camp by each department for the years included; and the amount of money contributed by departments and/or teachers to the Swimming Pool.

Also given, is a summary showing teachers who participated in week-end camping activities, and the number of persons brought to the Camp by teachers who may have changed schools.

In the seven schools with two teachers, all teachers are listed, and the number of campers brought is credited to the school where these teachers are working. It is not indicated when the second teachers were employed at the same school.

It is hoped that each teacher will review this report so he will have a knowledge of the fine support that is being given our Camp, which is designed to supplement the training that the students receive in school.

It is also hoped that this will stimulate ALL schools to do a better job.

There is no mention made of those few teachers who made deposits, but who for some reason that we do not know, failed to bring students to the Camp. So that in a very few cases, teachers made an effort to attend Camp, but for some reason were unable to do so.
