The meeting was called to order by Mr. Johnson with prayer and after which he stated the purpose of the meeting — To develop guidelines that will implement the Camp program and eradicate the existing petty grievances,

Johnson suggested that the group study the printed program for last year

The schedule was revised for the entire summer camping period. (June 8 - Aug. 14)

The Camp organizational procedure will remain as in past years. The camp staff will decide whether they divide the campers from each school or station all campers from each school in the same cabin.

It was the general consensus of those present that during the election, that registration books and a ballot box be used to make a real learning situation with democratic implications.

It was further agreed that an Adult Staff Member accompany the inspection committee in order that detail inspections and reports of major damages be incorporated in the reports.

Awards will be presented as in past years with emphasis on selection of the best individual camper in the various categories of activities, except in Leadership, Campus, and Athletics, which will demand separate recognition according to sex.

"Guidelines that may be used by the Manager in carrying out the Camping program at Simmons N.F.A. Camp for 1964" were discussed with those in attendance.

Suggestions from the Ag. Ed. Dept. ^{at AFT} were shared with the conferees.
